How to get to the Infopoint

Take S5, S7, S75 or S9 from your train stop at **Ostbahnhof** to **Friedrichstraße** (4 Stations), leave the station and follow **Friedrichstraße** up north until you reach the river. Don't cross it but turn right into **Am Weidendamm**. Go straight ahead until you reach a parking lot which you enter. The gymnasium you see there is our infopoint.



Train Stop:

The train stops at **Ostbahnhof** at 9am and leaves there at about 10pm. You will get to Ostbahnhof by: S3, S5, S7, S75 S9, Bus 140, 240, 347

Grocery stores:

-**Lidl & REWE** at Ostbahnhof (in the basement, cheap)
-**Edeka** at Bahnhof Friedrichstraße

Breakfast:

You will get your breakfast bag next to the steps of your train stop at **Ostbahnhof** immediately after leaving the train. You need to get a free voucher on the train!



Banks:

There is a Travel Bank "ReiseBank" at Ostbahnhof and all sorts of banks next to the station Friedrichstraße

11:00h-13:00h	Boat Trip	Price: 8.10 €	Berlin has more bridges than Venice, the city is surrounded by numerous waterways from which you'll get a great impression.
11:30h-13:30h	Berlin Wall	Price: free	The Wall separated Germany for 28 years. We'll try to show you a bit of the remains of the Wall and give you a little insight into its history.
13:30h-16:00h	German Historical Museum	Price: 5.00 €	We will be able to learn more about German history within its European context and its regional diversity by discovering epochs from the beginning of German history up to the present.
